1 <u>Mission</u>

- Promoting and preserving all pedigreed cats no matter which cat associations belong
- Establishing and promoting a fair platform for showing cats
- Teaching people about the health care, genetic disease prevention, grooming and beauty feline through seminars
- Showing and Educating members and social public about the importance of respecting cats

2. <u>Background</u>

A group of cat lovers from different countries in Asia with enthusiasm would like to establish the FIRST Asian pedigreed cat association. As pedigreed cats in Asia is growing rapidly and influences the cat fancy in the worldwide, it is time for our Asian to contribute ourselves to promote pedigreed cats and educate people about CATS.

Our goal is not only limited to holding cat shows but also conducting seminars to educate how to care about the health of cats, how to reduce the genetic problems, how to understand the behavior of cats and how to groom and make the cats beauty and clean.

FFF is going to establish a fair and professional platform to make all felines show off themselves. FFF is not only to promote the pedigreed cat show but also the fun show in order to make every cat breeder and owner keeping good conditions of their cats.

FFF focus is CATS. FFF will contribute ourselves to make cat fancy in Asia healthy and strong.

3. FFF Region and Structure

FFF is an Asian based pedigreed cat association. Our regions will divide into:

Each region has one (1) FFF recognized regional office ("RO"). The RO directly reports to the FFF's Board of Directors. Each RO has its members and cat clubs in the relevant region. Approval by the RO in the region should be obtained in organizing cat shows and seminars. RO reports to the Board of Directors.

4. <u>FFF Team</u>

FFF team is comprised of different cat lovers with professional knowledge in different aspects in different countries in Asia. We are 6 W:

- Well experienced cat breeders with renowned cat show results in different cat associations
- Well trained veterans, having professional knowledge on how to keep our cats in good health condition
- ↔ Well reputable cat groomers, with proven records of grooming cats in top show condition
- Well knowledgeable on cat pedigree and genetic, with track record of proving the truthfulness of cat pedigree
- ✤ Well covered in different countries in Asia, including Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Taiwan, Philippines, China, Russia and Europe.
- ✤ Well educated and reputable judges, from different cat associations

5. Show Season Period

FFF Show Season period is from 1 January to 31 December.

6. <u>Board</u>

The Board is composed of 5 members. President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary will be elected by the Board member for every 5 years.

Regional Directors will be appointed by the Board.

All resolutions in FFF will be passed by 2/3 votes by the Board members.



7. FFF Show Format

FFF has 2 formats of shows which are:

Kittens age from 4 months old to 8 months old. Adults age from 8 months old and above. Premiers age from 8 months old and above and must be neutered or spayed. Household pets age from 4 months old and above.

- A. Supernova
 - Encourage non-pedigreed cats to show and have fun in Supernova show
 - Both non-pedigreed and pedigreed cats can join
 - ONLY FFF registered supernova cats / pedigreed cats can accumulate Regional and National points in Supernova Cat Shows for earning the Regional Winner (SRW) and International Winner (SNW)
 - Non-registered cats will be entered as "Novice"
 - ✤ 4 classes which are (a) KITTEN (b) ADULT (c) PREMIER (d) HOUSEHOLD PET
- B. Pedigreed
 - Only Pedigreed cats can join the Pedigreed Cat Show
 - Pedigreed cats have the pedigree recognized by other cat association in worldwide from CFA,FIFE, TICA, WCF, ACFA, ICU, RUI.
 - ONLY FFF registered Pedigreed cats can accumulate Regional and National points for earning the Regional Winner (RW) and International Winner title (NW)
 - Non registered cats will be entered as "Novice"
 - ✤ 3 classes which are (a) KITTEN (b) ADULT (c) PREMIER
- 8. Pedigreed Cat Show Format
 - ✤ 3 classes which are (a) Kitten (b) Adult and (c) Premier
 - Each cat will be judged according to its own breed
 - Male and Female are judged and scored together
 - Upon judging ALL cats in the same breed, the following ribbons will be given:
 - (a) Best of Breed GOLD
 - (b) 2nd Best of Breed SILVER
 - (c) 3^{rd} Best of Breed COPPER
 - Only Open/Champion title cats will be competed for CH / PR finals.



- Each judge will pick 3 longhair champion cats with OP / CH title and 3 Shorthair champion cats with OP / CH title to the Champion finals. Amongst these 6 cats, each judge will pick 3 All Breed champion cats.
- All Kittens without KC title can entitle for Kitten Champion finals. Each judge will pick 3 longhair Open kittens, 3 Shorthair Open kittens. Amongst these 6 Open kittens, each judge will pick 3 All Breed Champion Kittens.
- Each judge will pick 3 longhair premier cats with OP / PR title and 3 Shorthair premier cats with OP IPR title to the Premier Champion finals. Amongst these 6 premier cats, each judge will pick 3 All Breed champion cats.
- ✤ Top 10 All Breed cats will be selected for the final in each class
- 7 Special Awards will be presented which are (a) Best Head Type (b) Best Coat (c) Best Color and Pattern (d) Best Body (e) Best Condition (f) FFF King and (g) FFF Queen
- Special Awards for (a) to (e) will be scored by each judge. The highest scoring cat of each award will be the winner. All classes are eligible to compete with these 5 special awards.
- Highest Scoring Male and Female in each class will be competed together and judged again by all judges at the end of the show. The Highest Scoring male will be FFF King in the show while the Highest Scoring female will be FFF Queen in the show.
- 9. <u>Supernova Cat Show Format</u>
 - ✤ 4 classes which are (a) Kitten (b) Adult (c) Premier and (d) HHP.
 - Only FFF Registered Supernova / Pedigreed cats can earn RW and NW points
 - Each cat will be judged according to its own breed
 - Male and Female are judged and scored together
 - ✤ Upon judging ALL cats in the same breed, the following ribbons will be given:
 - (a) Best of Breed GOLD
 - (b) 2nd Best of Breed SILVER
 - (c) 3rd Best of Breed COPPER
 - Top 15 cats will be selected for the final in each class
 - 7 Special Awards will be presented right after all rings finished judging, which are (a) Best Head Type

(b) Best Coat (c) Best Color & Pattern (d) Best Body (e) Best Condition (f) FFF Supernova King and (g) FFF Supernova Queen

- Special Awards for (a) to (e) will be scored by each judge. The highest scoring of each award will be the winner. All classes are eligible to compete with these 5 special awards.
- Highest Scoring Male and Female in each class will be competed together and judged again by all judges at the end of the show. The Highest Scoring male will be awarded as FFF Supernova King in the show while the Highest Scoring female will be awarded as FFF Supernova Queen in the show.



10. <u>Scoring Mechanism & Title</u>

RW and NW

For RW, BW and NW Scoring tables, please refer to Appendix 1. For KC, GC, GP scoring tables, please refer to Appendix 2.

For each All Breed ring, if the number of cats entered is over 50, score can be earned as:

Best: 100 2nd Best: 95 3rd Best: 90 4th Best: 85 5th Best: 80 6th Best: 75 7th Best: 70 8th Best: 65 9th Best: 60 10th Best: 55 For Kitten and A

- ✤ For Kitten and Adult class,
 - (a) Number of cats entered is less than 50, the score will be discounted by 30%.
 - (b) Number cats entered is less than 30, the scores will be discounted by 50%.
 - (c) Number of cats entered is less than 10, the scores will be discounted by 70%.
 - (d) Number of cats entered is 1 cat, the score will be 0.
- For Premier and HHP class,
 - (a) Number of cats entered is less than 30, the score will be discounted by 30%.
 - (b) Number cats entered is less than 15, the scores will be discounted by 50%.
 - (c) Number of cats entered is less than 5, the scores will be discounted by 70%.
 - (d) Number of cats entered is 1 cat, the score will be 0.
- For Specialty ring (Longhair / Shorthair), the score will be discounted by 50% from the All Breed ring.
- Each season, kittens can accumulate the points from the highest scoring 30 rings to earn the title of RW and NW.
- Each season, adults and premiers can accumulate the points from the highest scoring 80 rings to earn the title of RW and NW.

Breed Winner ("BW") title will be given to the Highest Scoring Cat in Adult class of each breed in Pedigreed Show Nationally

✤ The special awards will be presented to the highest scoring cat Nationally:

✤ The Title will only be given to the highest scoring cat NATIONALLY.



11. Adult GC Final Mechanism

Only cats with Open / Champion adult can entitle for Champion finals. Each judge will pick 3 longhair champion cats with OP / CH title and 3 Shorthair champion cats with OP / CH title to the Champion finals. Amongst these 6 cats, each judge will pick 3 All Breed champion cats.

3 longhair champion cats and 3 shorthair champion cats can earn the GC points as follows:
Best LH/SH champion: 50
2nd Best LH/SH champion: 40
3rd Best LH/SH champion: 30

✤ 3 All Breed Best champions cats can earn the GC points as follows:

Best AB Champion:
100
2 nd Best AB Champion:
80
3 rd Best AB Champion:
60

- If a cat obtains final in both LH/SH Champion and All Breed Champion finals, only the All Breed Champion finals will be scored.
- For Adult class,
 - (a) Number of CH cats entered is less than 50, the score will be discounted by 30%.
 - (b) Number of CH cats entered is less than 30, the scores will be discounted by 50%.
 - (c) Number of CH cats entered is less than 10, the scores will be discounted by 70%.
 - (d) Number of cats entered is 1 cat, the score will be 0.

✤ OP / CH title cats will become GC title cats upon accumulated 150 GC points.



12. <u>Kitten KC Final Mechanism</u>

- All Kittens without KC title can entitle for Kitten Champion finals. Each judge will pick 3 longhair Open kittens, 3 Shorthair Open kittens. Amongst these 6 Open kittens, each judge will pick 3 All Breed Champion Kittens.
- 3 longhair open kittens and 3 shorthair open kittens can earn the Score as: Best LH/SH Kitten Champion: 50 2nd Best LH/SH Kitten Champion: 40 3rd Best LH/SH Kitten Champion: 30
 All Broad Best Kitten Champion can earn the
- ✤ 3 All Breed Best Kitten Champion can earn the

score as: Best AB Kitten Champion: 100 2nd Best AB Kitten Champion: 80 3rd Best AB Kitten Champion: 60

- If a cat obtains final in both LH/SH Kitten Champion and All Breed Kitten Champion finals, only the All Breed Kitten Champion finals will be scored.
- For Kitten class,
 - (a) Number of kittens entered is less than 50, the score will be discounted by 30%.
 - (b) Number kittens entered is less than 30, the scores will be discounted by 50%.
 - (c) Number of kittens entered is less than 10, the scores will be discounted by 70%.
 - (d) Number of kittens entered is 1 cat, the score will be 0.
- Kittens with Open title will become KC title cats upon accumulated 150 Kitten Champion points.
- 13. Premier GP Final Mechanism
 - All Premiers with Open / Premiers can entitle for Premier Champion finals. Each judge will pick 3 longhair OP/PR premiers, 3 Shorthair OP/PR premiers. Amongst these 6 OP/PR premiers, each judge will pick 3 All Breed Premier cats.
 - 3 longhair OP/PR premiers and 3 shorthair OP/PR premiers can earn the score as: Best LH/SH Premier: 50
 2nd Best LH/SH Premiers: 40
 - 3rd Best LH/SH Premiers:

 3 All Breed Best Premiers can earn the score as: Best AB Premiers: 100 2nd Best AB Premiers: 80

- If a cat obtains final in both LH/SH Premiers and All Breed Premiers finals, only the All Breed Premiers finals will be scored.
- For Premier class,
 - (a) Number of premiers entered is less than 30, the score will be discounted by 30%.
 - (b) Number of premiers entered is less than 15, the scores will be discounted by 50%.
 - (c) Number of premiers entered is less than 5, the scores will be discounted by 70%.
 - (d) Number of premiers entered is 1 cat, the score will be 0.
- ✤ OP / PR title cats will become GP title cats upon accumulated 150 GP points.
- 14. <u>Transfer title from other cat associations</u>
 - FFF recognizes the title your cat has earned from other pedigreed association including CFA, TICA, FIFE, WCF, RUI, ICU. The certificate and evidences to prove the title and points earned in other cat association are required to recognize the title and bring the points to FFF.
 - FFF accepts the transfer of your cat from recognized cat association including CFA, TICA, FIFE, WCF,RUI, ICU. Please complete the cat transfer / registration form and provide the certificate issued by the abovementioned cat association in order to prove the eligibility.
 - If your cat has not yet been registered in other recognized cat association, you should provide the certificate of the sire and dam of the cat to be registered in FFF. If the certificate of the Sire and Dam is recognized, the cat can be automatically registered under FFF.



15. FFF Recognized Breeds

FFF recognizes 56 pedigreed breeds which comprised of 14 longhair breeds and 42 shorthair breeds. FFF will recognize more pedigreed breeds periodically after obtained 2/3 votes from the Board.

- 16. <u>Registration</u>
 - Registration Committee is responsible for checking the information provided and issue the litter and cat certificates
 - ✤ Each cat will be assigned a unique FFF cat registration number
 - The registration Number has 11 digits
 - (a) 1st digit either "P" or "S". P stands for Pedigreed cats and S stands for Supernova cats
 - (b) 2nd to 4th digit stands for the breed abbreviation. The breed code is listed under the clause 15.
 - (c) 5th to 6th digit stands for the regions the cat belongs to. Please kindly refer to below:
 - Thailand 01
 - China 02
 - Indonesia 03
 - ✤ Malaysia 04
 - Philippines 05
 - Hong Kong 06
 - Taiwan 07
 - Singapore 08
 - Europe 09
 - Russia 10
 - ✤ USA 11
 - 🛠 Japan 12
 - Korea 13
 - (d) 7th to 10th digits are the sequential number of the cat in the specified breed by gender
 - (e) 11th digit stands for the gender. "M" stands for male and "F" stands for female.
- A. Pedigreed Cat
 - FFF recognizes pedigree from recognized cat association such as CFA, FIFE, TICA, WCF, RUI, ICU
 - Complete the cat registration form manually or register litter / cat online via FFF web site.
 - If the Sire and Dam of the cat to be registered do not have FFF registration number, the certificate copies of Sire and Dam from other cat association should be provided
 - ✤ The cat should be registered via the cat registration but not via the litter registration.
 - Information such as cat name, date of birth, Sire, Dam, Breed, Color, Sex, Breeder Name and Owner name should be provided
 - If the Sire and Dam of the cat to be registered have FFF registration number, the cat will be required to register the litter before registered as cat.
 - Information regarding to the litter such as litter date, number of kittens born, breeder name and owner name should be provided.
 - The registration committee will review all information provided. If all required information is provided, registration committee will prepare the cat certificate.



- The certificate of pedigreed cats is green in color
- B. Supernova Cat
 - ✤ Pedigreed cats can also register as Supernova cats and join the Supernova cat show
 - If there is no pedigree registered in other cat association, cats can be register as Supernova Cats
 - Complete the FFF Supernova Cat registration form manually or online register
 - Information such as Cat name, birth date, color, breed, Sex, owner name should be provided
 - Registration committee will review the information. If all required information is provided, registration committee will issue the Supernova cat certificate
 - Supernova cat certificate is blue in color
- 17. Judging Program Pedigreed Shows
 - ✤ Judges cannot judge a cat with his / her owner name and breeder name
 - Judges are required to perform in a professional and integrity manner no matter inside or outside the judging rings
 - A. Eligibility for FFF Pedigreed Cat Show
 - ✤ Applicant must be at least eighteen (18) years of age
 - ✤ Five (5) years of breeding experience in one of the worldwide recognized cat association.
 - Applicant can apply both specialties provided that the requirement of each specialty is fulfilled
 - Exhibiting requirements:
 - (a) An applicant must have exhibited actively in either one of the worldwide recognized cat associations for Five (5) years.
 - (b) Exhibited at least 1 FFF cat show
 - (c) A resume of awards obtained for the cats exhibiting must be provided
 - (d) At least Two (2) different breeds exhibited for the specialty applied
 - (e) A resume of the exhibition experience must be provided with photos
 - Clerked at least 1 FFF cat show with satisfactory evaluation from an All Breed judge or a licensed ring clerk in FFF.
 - A licensed master clerk in FFF or licensed master clerk in other pedigreed cat associations.
 - ✤ Attend the FFF Judging School one time.
 - Attend the Breed Introduction seminar arranged by the Breed Council to learn FFF breed standard.
 - ✤ Breed council member of one FFF recognized breed
 - ✤ Pass the examination with 80% score
 - ✤ Interview with the delegate from the Board of Directors and the Chairperson of the



judging program will be conducted to evaluate the capability of the applicant.

- ✤ All information submits to the Judging Program Committee in FFF Headquarter.
- Two Third favorite votes from the Board can obtain the status of trainee.
- For the second specialty application, Applicant is required to fulfill the requirements as stated above

B. Pedigree judge advancement

- (a) Trainee > Approval Pending
 - The first status for the applicant in the Pedigreed Show is Trainee in the FIRST specialty
 - Trainee judge is required to seek the approval from the judging program committee for training.

Judging program committee will arrange the mentoring judge for the training.

Trainee judge at least needs to judge 2 shows for the single specialty together with an Approved judge. Approved judge will share and advise the skills and knowledge with the trainee judge.

Evaluation form from the mentoring judge will be completed. The evaluation form will send directly to the Board

- ✤ If the evaluation is failed, more shows are required to be trained.
- Trainee judge is required to attend the specialized breed handling training 2 times.
- ✤ Pass the examination with 80% scores.
- Once the advancement requirement is met, the trainee judge writes to the Board and asks forconsideration of advancement in the coming Board meeting.
- Trainee judge will be advanced to Approval Pending judges by passing two-thirds (2/3) favorable vote from the Board of Directors in the coming Board meeting.
- Trainee is required to bear all expenditures during training including transportation, hotel fees and meal fees. Trainee is not eligible for the judging fees.

(b) Approval Pending > Approved

- Approval Pending judge at least needs to judge 2 shows for the single specialty ring by their own.
- Evaluation form will be completed by the show manager. The completed evaluation form will send to the Board directly by the show manager.
- Once the advancement requirement is met, the approval pending judge writes to the Board andasks for consideration of advancement in the coming Board meeting.
- Examination should be performed. 80% scores should be obtained for reaching the minimum requirement for advancement.
- Approval Pending judge will be advanced to Approval judge by passing twothirds (2/3) favorable vote from the Board of Directors in the coming Board meeting.

(c) 2nd Specialty

✤ Trainee and Approval Pending judge for the 1st specialty can submit the application for



the 2nd specialty

- Attendance at breed seminar and handling seminar is required for the appropriate specialty.
- The advancement procedure of the 2nd specialty follows the procedure pursuant to the 1st specialty
- Upon become approved in the 2nd specialty, the status of the judge is Approval Pending All Breed.

(d) Approval Pending All Breed

- Approval Pending All Breed judge needs to judge 2 shows as a All Breed judge in order to entitle for advancement of Approved All Breed judge
- Evaluation form will be completed by the show manager. The completed evaluation form will send to the Board directly.
- Once the advancement requirement is met, the approval pending judge writes to the Board and asks for consideration of advancement in the coming Board meeting.
- Approval Pending All Breed judge will be advanced to Approval All Breed judge by passing two-thirds (2/3) favorable vote from the Board of Directors in the coming Board meeting.
